## PARADE RULES

1. For safety reasons we ask participants to not throw candy or similar items from moving vehicles. Participants walking alongside their parade entries may hand out candy or other similar items to people along the parade route.
2. Any person operating a motor vehicle in the parade shall be a licensed driver. All applicable seat belt and/or helmet laws must be obeyed by all participants.
3. Keep the parade moving! Let's make this an enjoyable parade without any gaps.
4. We encourage entries to reflect the theme of the parade in their decorations, dress, etc.
5. If your entry has animals, you are responsible for the immediate clean-up of any mess that they may make along the parade route or in the staging area.
6. All parade entries (floats) must be in their assigned spaces by 11:30 am on the day of the parade in order to be judged. Other entries not being judged must be in their assigned spaces by 12:25 pm.
7. With our space for parade line-up and a short parade route we cannot accommodate large semi trucks. We encourage floats to be constructed using a hay wagon or similar type trailer.
